The State Ministry Coordinator...

Represents and communicates the goals and objectives of the SBCAL and the vision of the Executive Director to Associational Leaders, the State Director of Missions and other staff, Church Planting Catalysts, and other pertinent ministry leaders.

Gives valuable input to the Regional Ministry Coordinator, the Executive Team, and the Executive Director about the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats faced by that state's Associational Leaders. Informs the Executive Director of new and retiring DOMs.

Promotes membership in the SBCAL among anyone involved in associational ministry – Associational Leaders, Church Planting Catalysts, Moderators, the State Director of Missions, other State Missionaries, etc. – paid or volunteer

Helps his Regional Ministry Coordinator plan the program and secure sponsorships from SBC entities, State Convention entities, and other appropriate ministries for their region's fall or winter conference, if applicable

Is on the lookout for Best Practices and Model Practitioners to share with fellow Associational Leaders, the Regional Ministry Coordinator, and the Executive Director
